Surviving Puberty!



**DIY FIRST PERIOD
KIT**

Acknowledge emotions

Mood swings, irritability, and self-consciousness are common. Help them understand it's linked to hormones, and support healthy coping strategies.

Talk about hygiene

Explain the importance of deodorant, regular showers, clean clothes, and looking after skin and hair.

Support body confidence

Avoid negative comments about appearance—your own or theirs. Praise their strengths and remind them bodies come in all shapes and sizes

Friendships

- **Listen without judgment**
- When your child talks about their friends, try to listen more than you speak. Avoid rushing to solutions or criticisms of their peers
- **Normalise ups and downs**
- Friendships at this age can be intense and sometimes short-lived. Reassure your child that it's normal for groups and dynamics to change
- **Keep perspective**
- Secondary friendships can feel “all or nothing” to your child. Remind them that friendship skills grow over time and it's okay to make mistakes.
- **Don't panic about “drama”**
- Social spats are part of learning. Step in if there's bullying, but otherwise help your child reflect on what they can do differently next time.
- **Encourage offline time**
- Friendships often spill onto social media. Help them balance online chats with real-life time together to strengthen connections

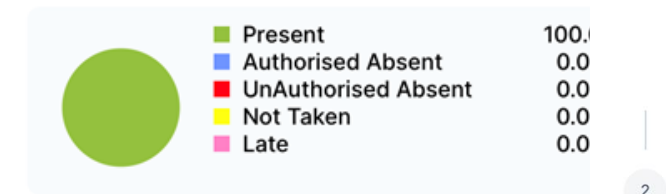
