STUDENTS FROM OTHER SCHOOLS (Not PHS students) – Please remember to include a scanned/photographed copy of your GCSE results statement with your email.

Option 1: If you have gained the correct grades and wish to accept your offer with no changes to subject choices, email us and we will register you. For PHS students there is then nothing else that you need to do prior to the start of term. Students from other schools will be sent a link to complete their student registration.

OR

Option 2: If you have gained the minimum entry requirement to join the Sixth Form but have either not achieved the correct entry grades for a subject you originally expressed an interest in or have now changed your mind and wish to request different subject options, email us and we will consider change requests in the order we receive them. Whilst we will make every effort to meet requests, changing your choices at this stage is dependent on course numbers following confirmation of offers already held by other applicants. This means we may not be able to confirm your request immediately but will do so as soon as we can.

OR

Option 3: If you do not wish to take up your offered place, PHS students are required to inform us of their chosen alternative course and provider or employment destination. This will also enable places to be released for students on our waiting list.
